Art and Science of Homeopathy

Homeopathy is a unique system of healing. Homeopathic medicine matches individual remedies to individual persons in a holistic manner that encompasses the spiritual, mental, emotional and physical levels of that person.

Homeopathy treats the whole person, rather than merely the presenting symptom, or complaint of a patient. Healing is achieved by using very small doses of natural substances to stimulate the body's ability to cure itself. In this way, Homeopathy heals and strengthens the whole person and helps prevent future illness by finding and treating the root cause of disease, rather than suppressing its symptoms.

Samuel Hahnemann (1755-1843), a German physician, first demonstrated Homeopathy as a method of therapy over 200 years ago. Homeopathy is a very distinct and complete system of medicine based on the simple principle of healing called the *Law of Similars*, or 'Like Cures Like'. This means that a substance that produces symptoms in a healthy person will cure those very symptoms in a sick person. The basic concept is that symptoms are the body's way of trying to heal.

Hahnemann found that when he took liquefied Peruvian bark, the source of quinine and the main treatment for malaria at the time, he replicated symptoms similar to those suffering from malaria.

In a series of experiments, Hahnemann gave this bark as a Homeopathic preparation, *China officinalis*, to people with malaria and found that they recovered from the disease. This "like cures like" principle led Hahnemann to call this form of therapy Homeopathy. "Homoeos" is the Greek term for similar; and "pathos" means suffering or disease, hence 'similar suffering'.

Many Uses

Homeopathy is successful in the treatment of both acute and chronic disorders. In acute diseases, such as fevers, pain or diarrhea, the symptoms shown are the body's attempt to kill the attacking organism and expel the toxin. This encourages the person to slow down and rest in order to aid the body in healing itself.

In chronic disease, the symptoms are attempts by the body to heal itself, but is unable to succeed. When the body is not strong enough to fight off disease, a chronic condition develops with symptoms lasting for months or years, creating a life-long pattern of debility.

Homeopathy is also used to treat many common acute and chronic pediatric problems, including: asthma, allergies, colic, croup, eczema, behavioral disorders, otitis media, and diarrhea. Determination of treatment by a Homeopathic professional involves an extensive interview. Physical health problems, family history, sleep patterns, food preferences, temperament, and behavioral patterns are all considered vitally important. Because Homeopathic medicines are so dilute, they are extremely safe to use. Even hospitalized patients can safely receive Homeopathic medicines to help reduce pain or nausea, and enhance recovery from trauma.

The mentoring program focuses on your transition from student to Homeopathic practitioner. You will be taking cases and have your mentor to help guide you. This will help with your confidence as a practicing Homeopath. Most schools provide the education, but we take it one step further by giving you the education and a guide so you can practice as an excellent Homeopath. The mentors that we assign to students are already established Homeopaths in the US and have been practicing many years. The mentoring program starts during the 3rd year. You will need to complete 10 months, one hour per month, of mentoring to complete the program to earn your diploma.

Clinic Internship Program

The Los Angeles School of Homeopathy is dedicated to teaching students to become professional homeopaths. Our clinic is an integral part of that effort. Each case will be taken by two homeopaths; one as the primary homeopath to take the case and one to be a silent observer homeopath. The primary homeopath will be in charge of taking the case and presenting the case to the supervisor as well as being the contact for the patient. The observer homeopath will also take the case and receive credit hours for this as well. Each student intern will take turns being the primary homeopath and observer homeopath on cases. Having a primary homeopath and observer on a case serves to enhance your case taking skills, as well as having someone with whom to discuss the case and remedy selection. After taking the case students will discuss their remedy selection with their clinic supervisor.

Student intern homeopaths are required to complete 30 hours at the clinic under the supervision of a professional homeopath.

Demand for Homeopaths is increasing, as this area of natural health care is becoming more widely accepted by health professionals and the public. As a result of intensive training over three years in the LASH Diploma course in Homeopathy, LASH graduates enter professional practice possessing a sound education that enables them to handle the demands of Homeopathic practice in the 21st Century.

Steps to Enrollment

Once you have made contact with the school and/or been sent a copy of the prospectus, registration and application forms, the LASH enrollment coordinator will contact you by email or phone to discuss the course. This is an excellent opportunity for you to discuss concerns and questions.

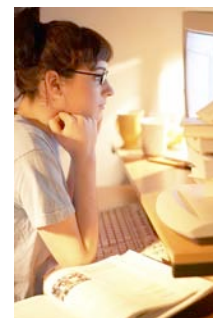

School Requirements

Attendance and Completion:

Each year you will receive a Certificate of Completion.
