Art and Science of Homeopathy

Homeopathy is a unique system of medicine, by addressing a person's individual disposition including the spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical attributes. Homeopathic remedies are administered in very small doses of natural substances to stimulate the body's ability to restore health, rather than suppressing symptoms. Samuel Hahnemann (1755-1843), a German physician, first demonstrated homeopathy as a method of medicine over 200 years ago. Homeopathy is a distinct and complete system of medicine based on the simple principle of healing called the Law of Similars, or 'Like Cures Like.' This means that a substance that produces symptoms in a healthy person will cure those very symptoms in an unwell person.

Many Uses

Homeopathy is successful in the treatment of both acute and chronic disorders. In acute situations, such as fevers, pain, or diarrhea, a homeopathic remedy will help guide the body to restorative health. When the body has attempted unsuccessfully to heal itself, a person may have symptoms for several months or longer. A weakened immune response is then unable to heal deep-seated disease and a chronic condition can develop. Homeopathy addresses these chronic conditions and aims to heal on the deepest level.

The World Health Organization has stated that Homeopathy is the second largest growing form of medicine. Homeopathy is the most widely practiced alternative form of medicine, it is estimated that over 400 million people worldwide and 6 million people in the United States use homeopathic medicines as their primary form of medicine. Mentorship focuses on your transition from student to Homeopathic practitioner. You will be taking cases and discussing them with your mentor before making the final remedy suggestion. This one-on-one support encourages and develops your confidence as a practicing Homeopath. Mentors are professional Homeopaths with many years of practice and experience. Mentoring starts in your 2nd year and continues throughout your 3rd year. You will complete 20 months of mentorship, which is 200 hours.

Internship

The Los Angeles School of Homeopathy is dedicated to teaching students to become professional Homeopaths. Our Clinic is an integral part of that effort. Student Interns interview clients with the Clinic Supervisor while the other interns observe the case-taking. Cases are discussed as a group and the remedy is chosen after careful research under the guidance of the Clinic Supervisor. Student intern homeopaths are required to complete 300 hours in the 2nd and 3rd years at the Internship Clinic under the supervisor of a professional homeopath.

Optional Fourth-Year Program

This optional year supports the Graduate in transitioning from a Student Homeopath to a professional Homeopath. Through continued case care and discussions with a mentor in small, personalized monthly groups, the 4th year student will deepen their understanding of Materia Medica and their sense of a community of professionals.

The LASH enrollment coordinator will contact you by email or phone to discuss the course. Once you have read all of the school information, you have the opportunity to discuss any concerns and/or questions.

- You will need to fill out the registration, application, and admissions financial readiness forms. Upon completion of the forms, please scan and email them back to us, including the nonrefundable registration fee.
- You must be at least 18 years of age, have a high school diploma or GED, and have an open mind and a desire to make a difference in your community. Access to a computer & internet will be required.
- When the school has received your forms, the LASH Enrollment coordinator will contact you.
- Admissions interview; to ensure we have answered all our questions about the school. This process also involves a discussion of your tuition, expectations, and how best to manage your studies.
- After committing to the course, payment of the tuition fee is due. Please see the registration form and admissions financial readiness form. You will be notified of acceptance by mail.

Attendance and Completion:

For three years, a total of 1000 hours without electives. Students must complete the requirements for the current year before continuing to the next year. A Diploma earning you the designation D. In order to graduate each student will be required to demonstrate a high level of competency in the practicing homeopathy.

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
